ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

This program is open to students 12 years and older, by audition only. Students will be accepted on suitability to full time dance training geared towards a professional career in dance. The focus will be on ballet, but may include some or all of the following: conditioning, modern, character, jazz, composition, repertoire, history, and music, dependant on the program determined and level of study.

Dance students interested in the Professional Program from Grade 7 – 12 may be interested in combining their academic and dance program through a Performing Arts School Collaboration.

Admitted by audition and recommendation, these students study their academic subjects and their performing arts subjects as part of their school days as well as some after school and weekend hours.

Post Secondary Program

This is also available as a post secondary professional program designed to boost and expand the technical & artistic level of serious students who are hoping to pursue a dance career.

Entrance into this program is by audition & interview. The applying student must have successfully completed High School.

TUITION

Tuition for this program is \$4600.00 per
